

EASTERN EUROPE GRANDEUR

Day 01. Zurich-Innsbruck

- Arrival Zurich and transfer to Innsbruck. Enjoy the most beautiful landscapes of Vaduz, Liechtenstein. Later proceed to Innsbruck.
- · Overnight at hotel.

Day 02. Innsbruck

- After breakfast visit the small town of Wattens in Tyrol would have little claim to fame if it wasn't home to the world's leading manufacturer of tacky glass crystals: Swarovski.
- · Overnight at hotel.

Day 03. Innsbruck-Salzburg

- After breakfast, check out from the hotel & drive to Salzburg.
- Welcome to Salzburg! Salzburg means "salt castle" The city's magnificent Baroque town center is rated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site and can easily be explored by foot. Day 04. Salzburg

- Breakfast at the hotel. Free time at leisure.
- Overnight at the hotel.

Day 05. Salzburg - Cesky Krumlov - Prague

- After breakfast check out from the hotel & drive through Cesky Krumlov.
- During visit to Český Krumlov you will have the opportunity to admire the beautiful South Bohemian countryside, with its picturesque villages and many ponds. Český Krumlov is a town on the UNESCO Heritage List. This unique urban complex, comprising three hundred historical houses and the National Castle and Chateau, the second largest after Prague Castle draws many visitors every year and is rightly called the "PEARL OF THE RENAISSANCE"
- · Further proceed to Prague.
- · Overnight at the hotel.

Day 06. Prague

- After breakfast at the hotel enjoy guided city tour of Prague includes the Golden Prague: State Opera, the National Museum and Wenceslas Square & Charles Square to the Banks of the river Vltava and across the river to Prague Castle. There a walk around the castle courtyards awaits you. Where among other things, you will have a chance to see the St. Vitus Cathedral. Later in the old town, we see the St. Nicholas Church, the Tyn Church and the Old Town Hall with its Astronomical Clock (horologe) and the 12 Apostles. Finally visit the Jewish quarter and through the Old Town Square to Wenceslas Square.
- · Overnight at the hotel

Day 07. Prague-Dresden - Berlin

After breakfast check out from hotel & drive to Dresden Dresden, the former capital of Saxony.
 Badly damaged by Allied bombing in February 1945, the city has since been restored to its baroque splendor. During your walking tour, admire the architecture of the Zwinger Palace and Semper Opera. Next, drive to Berlin Overnight at hotel.

Day 08. Berlin

- Breakfast at the hotel. City Tour of Berlin visit places such as East Side Gallery, Unter den Linden, Museum Island, Government district, Reichstag, Brandenburger Gate, Bellevue Castle, Column of Victory, Kurfürstendamm, Holocaust Memorial, Potsdamer Platz, Topographie of Terror, the remains of the Berlin Wall, Hitler's Bunker, Checkpoint Charlie and much more.
- · Overnight at hotel.

Day 09. Berlin - Poznan - Warsaw

- After breakfast check out from the hotel & drive to Poznan Cross the Polish border, enjoy vistas
 of rural life in the fertile central plains, and take a break in the historic river port of Poznan on
 your way to Warsaw.
- · Overnight at the hotel.

Day 10. Warsaw

- Breakfast at the hotel. City tour of Warsaw. Visit Old Town area, Royal Castle, Old Market Square and Barbican. Following Royal Route you will see Presidential Palace, University of Warsaw, Holy Cross Church with Chopin's heart, Copernicus Statue. More highlights of Warsaw sightseeing include: New Town with Monument of Warsaw Uprising, Jewish Ghetto, Tomb of Unknown Soldier, Palace of Culture and Science. In the afternoon we visit the famous Łazienki Royal Park with Palace on the Water and Chopin Monument. Visit one of the most beautiful monuments of the Polish baroque architecture Palace in Wilanów, French and English style gardens adorned with stone statues and buildings like little Neogothic castle.
- · Overnight at hotel.

Day 11. Warsaw - Czestochowa-Auschwitz-Krakow

 Breakfast at the hotel. Check out & drive to visit JASNA GÓRA, the monastery near Czestochowa, and admire its BLACK MADONNA, which is venerated as the "Queen of Poland" and has become the country's national symbol. Next, stop in Auschwitz to visit what is left of the CONCENTRATION CAMP, a chilling reminder of the Holocaust. Evening arrival in Krakow Overnight at hotel.

Day 12. Krakow

Breakfast at the hotel. City tour of Krakow . Barbican, Florian Gate; Kazimierz - former Jewish

District; Wawel Hill- Royal Castle and Cathedral; walking via Royal Route – Grodzka Street to old Market Square European largest Mediaeval square with the Renaissance Cloth Hall "Sukiennice", St Mary's Basilica with the unique altar curved in wood .Overnight at the hotel.

Day 13. Krakow – Bratislava – Budapest

After breakfast check out & drive to a scenic day taking you right through the heart of
mountainous and densely wooded Slovakia, where brown bears still roam free. Approach
Budapest soon after arriving in the wide open valley of the Danube River. Evening enjoy the
folklore performance Overnight at hotel.

Day 14. Budapest.

- After breakfast City tour of Budapest & visit Roosevelt Square (Chain Bridge), Academy of Sciences, Parliament, St. Stephen's Cathedral, Opera House, Heroes Square, Millennium Monument, City Park, Szechecnyi Spa, Vajdahunyad Castle, Chain Bridge, Royal Palace, Liberty Statue & the Citadel.
- · Overnight at hotel.

Day 15. Budapest - Zagreb

- After breakfast check out from the hotel & drive to Zagreb. Drive along Lake Balaton and stop to take a view of beautifully situated Abbey of Tihany.
- · Overnight at the hotel.

Day 16. Zagreb - Rijeka

 Breakfast at the hotel Check out from hotel & drive to Rijeka, an important port in the Adriatic Sea. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 17. ijeka – Ljubljana - Vienna

After breakfast drive to Vienna via Ljubljana.

Later City tour of Vienna: This tour will give you an overall impression of the most significant historical sights of Vienna: along the Ringstrasse the State Opera House, the magnificent Museum of Fine Arts with its world-famous art treasures of the Habsburgs and the Natural History Museum, the cultural district the Museums Quartier, the Hofburg (the former Habsburg winter residence), the Parliament, the City Hall and the Burg theater. The highlight of this tour will be a visit of the showrooms of Schönbrunn Palace, once the summer residence of the Habsburg family and home of Maria Theresia. On the way back to the opera we pass by the Belvedere Palace. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 18. Vienna

Breakfast at the hotel & transfer to airport.
